Who needs an RST?

From April 2008, or April 2007 if you're under 25, the person in charge of a vessel with a motor of 4.5 kilowatts (6HP) or more must hold an RST. You must be 14 years of age to hold an RST. However those between 14 and 16 are restricted to 8 Knots and can only operate in Daylight Hours.

What does the Course include?

- Theory Training
- Theory Test (80% pass mark required)
- Practical Training
- Practical Assessment

Ask about our Theory Training and/or Test only for Experienced Recreational boat owners who have been issued with an exemption letter from the Department of Planning and Infrastructure.

On successful completion of the course you will receive:

- WA Recreational Skipper's Ticket.

This applies to all unqualified boat drivers in Western Australia



RESTRICTED COXSWAIN COURSE

The Restricted Coxswains Course has especially been designed for corporate groups or people needing to obtain a marine qualification to work on vessels in the workplace.

- Three Full Days

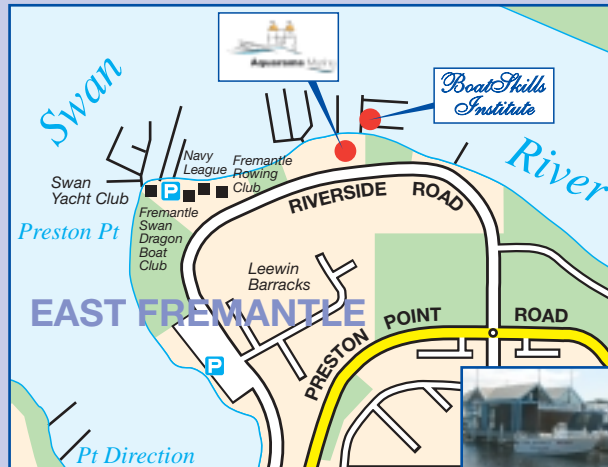

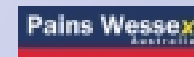
